The Cutaneous Lymphoma Foundation is pleased to announce we are soliciting applications for our Young Investigator Award for the International Conference on Malignant Lymphoma (ICML) to be held June 17 - 21, 2025 in Lugano, Switzerland.

This year we will be offering one \$1,500 award in support of Young Investigators. Qualified applicants must be both attending and presenting cutaneous lymphoma-related research at the ICML Annual Meeting.

Criteria for selection of the Young Investigator Award includes:

- Individuals with an M.D. or Ph.D. degree.
- Individuals with an academic rank no greater than assistant professor and within three years of first faculty appointment.
- Individuals with demonstrable interest and/or achievement in clinical care, education or research in cutaneous lymphomas.
- Individuals who have submitted an abstract and will be presenting research at the 2025 ICML Annual Meeting.
